

A visit to the Pilsen City Hall

Pilsen with its 165,000 inhabitants is the biggest city in West Bohemia. It was founded in 1295 as the royal town on the influence of four rivers. The town became a busy trade centre on the route to the German towns Nuremburg and Regensburg.



The historic city centre has the dominant – St. Bartholomew’s Cathedral with the highest church tower in Bohemia (102.6m). There are valuable historic houses around the Square of the Republic in Gothic, Renaissance and Baroque styles.

The City Hall is a real gem of Renaissance architecture.
